Stella Rosso 2008 €6.00 / 20.00

Vinho Regional Peninsula De Setubal, Portugal
Grape: Castelao (50%), Syrah (50%). Style: Fruity, medium bodied
black cherries, spice and plums with a touch of chocolate richness and a
bright grippy acidity and tannins.

Merlot Les Jamelles 2009 5.50/22.00

Fruity and complex with cherry and cinnamon aromas, it has a smooth soft
and velvety style

Moulin de Gassac 2010 (Organic) 4.50/18.00

Languedoc, Pays d'Herault IGP
Produced by the legendary Guibert family. A robust sophisticated syrah-
grenache blend. Well balanced palate with hints of red fruity jam and a
touch of pepper. Great with roast and grilled meat, poultry and cheese

Domaine des Anges, Ventoux Rouge 2007 5.75/23.00

Southern Rhone, Cotes du Ventoux
Grape: 75% Grenache, 25% Syrah. Style: Full bodied, oaked
Irish-owned and made by an Irishman. Rich raspberry flavours with
touches of liquorice and chocolate on the nose. Subtle woodland fruits on
the palate, followed by silky tannins leading to a full, rich finish.

Château de Bastet 2009 (Biodynamic) 7.00/28.00

Cuvée du Nelly Côtes du Rhône, France
From a fully certified biodynamic vineyard, this is a blend of 80% Grenache
and 20% Syrah. Juicy, medium-bodied wine with hints of crushed
raspberries and spice. Ideal with beef, spicy and vegetarian dishes.

Rioja Muriel Crianza 2007 5.75/23.00

Very intense on the nose, with spicy and balsamic aromas against a
background of ripe fruit. Complete and round with surprising silkiness and
elegance.

Château Laroche Clauzet 2003 Médoc 7.25/29.00

65% Cabernet, 35% Merlot. This Medoc has aromas of prunes and ripe
fruits with spicy and toasted undertones. Rich and fruity on the palate, it
has smooth tannins and enough acidity to pair any meat dish.
